

Happy Tails

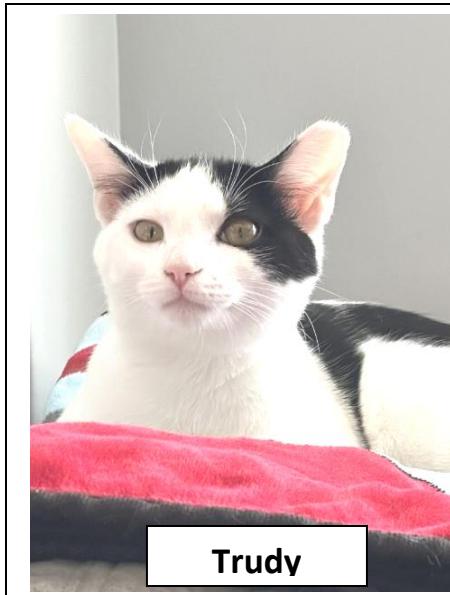

Trudy

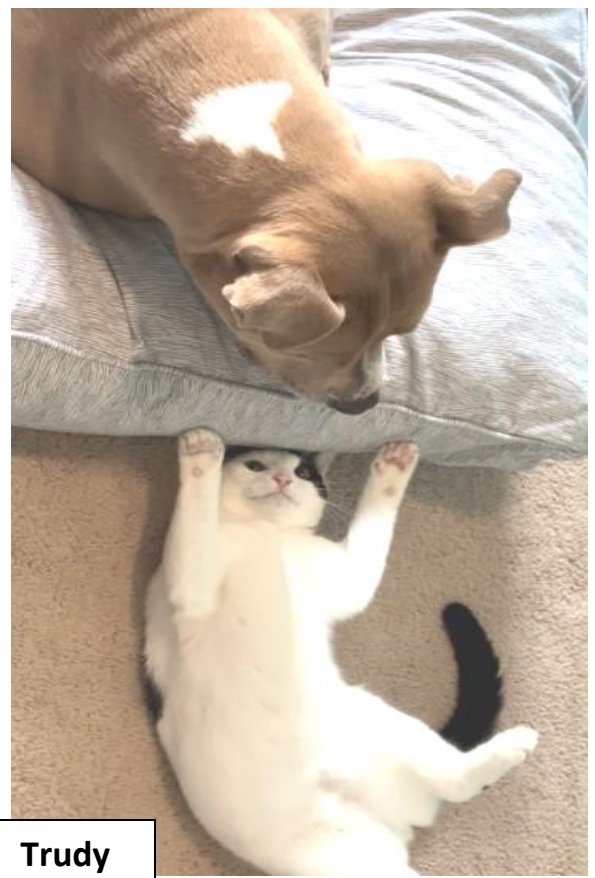
Trudy was not a planned adoption!
